# Circular - Reopening of College

As per the Government of Karnataka Order number RD 158 TNR 2020 dated 16/07/2021 the college will reopen and offline classes will commence from Monday the 19<sup>th</sup> July 2021. Students are requested to report to the hostel on Sunday the 18<sup>th</sup> July 2021 by 05:00 PM.

#### Note:

- Submission of Hardcopy of the RTPCR Negative report to the Warden at the time of reporting to the Hostel is mandatory from all the 147 students. (RAT test will not be accepted).
- 2) Validity of the RTPCR report should not be more than 48 hours.
- 3) As mentioned in the Government order at least one dose of vaccination against COVID-19 is compulsory. Hardcopy of the Vaccination certificate should be submitted to the warden at the time of Reporting. (Note: Any students not being vaccinated will provide an undertaking).
- 4) The COVID Protocols as enclosed should be strictly followed. Any deviations would result in serious action.

# COVID PROTOCOLS TO BE FOLLOWED AT CDSIMER

# **DO'S**:

- At least one dose of vaccination against COVID-19 is compulsory. (Note: Any students not being vaccinated will provide an undertaking). Hard copy of the Vaccination certificate is a must to be submitted to the warden at the time of Reporting.
- Physical distancing to be followed compulsorily.
- Use of Face Mask (**Preferably N95**) is mandatory inside the CDISMER premises. (**Students will be penalized with a fine for not wearing mask inside the CDSIMER premises**)
- Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly.
- Use of sanitizer before entering into the Lecture Hall, Laboratories, Gym, Library and Dissection Hall is mandatory.
- Always carry a personal sanitizer bottle.
- Compulsory use of Sanitizer after using biometric attendance.
- Submission of Hardcopy of the RTPCR Negative report to the Warden at the time of reporting to the Hostel is mandatory from all the 147 students. Validity of the RTPCR report should not be more than 48 hours.
- Students should compulsorily be seated in alternate chairs inside the Lecture Hall.

- Preferably use of masks inside the hostel room during interaction with roommates.
- Students with any symptoms of (Cough / Cold / Fever / Difficulty in breathing) should inform the warden or mentor immediately.
- Maintain social distance even in the Mess.
