- **Outcome of the training (250 words)**

Through this celebration more than 550 stake holders were engaged in the events conducted. Knowledge about Pharamcovigilance was spread across all the stake holders including doctors, nurses, technicians, medical students, pharmacists, post graduates and general public.

Day 1 outcome:

Program was inaugurated in presence of chief of Dean and Principal Dr AC Ashok on 17-Sep-2021 and followed by his talk on "**Importance of Identification and Reporting of ADRs**". Dr Ashok mentioned that "All drugs are having therapeutic effects. But they will also produce adverse drug reactions. Students should be aware of them, look for new ADRs which are not mentioned in standard text books and take measures to prevent them from causing further damage to patients" he informed. Series of events followed after his talk including talk by Dr Dr Madan Gaikwad Special officer, Dr Rajagopalan S Medical Director, Dr Prashanth Kumar Vice Principal, Dr Pratibha Nadig Prof and HOD Pharmacology and Dr Asha Benakappa Prof and HOD, department of Paediatrics. All the dignitaries encouraged reporting of ADRs and stressed the importance this activity in preventing them.

Public awareness and engagement program was conducted on 17-Sep-2022 with a rally from college building to hospital building was organized. Self medication in children can be dangerous and it may affect various important organs like kidney, liver and eyes etc. they informed not to do self medication and all the unused medications should be discarded properly. **"Expired drugs also can cause life threatening adverse events"**. She also shared her experience in changing prescription practices and change in preferred drug status for various drugs due to Pharmacovigilance activities. Dr AC Ashok mentioned in his talk about various drugs that were removed from market due to their serious and intolerable adverse drug effects. Dr Prasad addressed the gathering and stressed on the importance of pharmacovigilance activities. He mentioned that every medical college and hospital should have these kind of programs and IMA will support future events also.
